



Regional Sediment Management Subsection 204 (e)

There is a little-known provision under the authority of the Regional Sediment Management Program to provide comprehensive assistance to states and unit of local government (with the support of the state) in development RSM plans to better manage sediment resources for beach nourishment, land reclamation, habitat restoration, development of wetlands and marshes and more.

(e) State and regional plans

The Secretary may-

- (1) cooperate with any State or group of States in the preparation of a comprehensive State or regional sediment management plan within the boundaries of the State or among States;
- (2) encourage State participation in the implementation of the plan; and
- (3) submit to Congress reports and recommendations with respect to appropriate Federal participation in carrying out the plan.
